Should one of your employees test positive for the COVID-19 virus, it is critical that you report the situation to your Peraton procurement point of contact immediately. Swift notification allows us to assist in containment which may include having personnel in contact with the infected test for the virus, disinfect the facilities more thoroughly, and/or report to a landlord or customer as appropriate.
