Subject: Peraton Response to COVID-19 Vaccination Executive Order - Update

Dear Valued Subcontractor,

On November 10, 2021, the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force issued updated guidance regarding federal contractor compliance with <u>Executive Order 14042</u>, Ensuring Adequate COVID Safety Protocols for Federal Contractors (the "EO"), extending the deadline for employees of Federal contractors to be vaccinated to January 18, 2022 to align with the newly announced OSHA and CMS deadlines.

In accordance with the Safer Federal Workforce Task Force's updated guidance, Federal Contractors cannot offer contractors, subcontractors and lower-tier subcontractor employees who support covered contracts or work in covered contractor workspaces the testing option that is available under OSHA's rule. Accordingly, as Peraton's prime contracts are amended to include the required clause, Peraton will flow down that clause to its subcontractors.

Based on the pending litigation challenging the EO, Peraton will continue to monitor the status of the EO and promptly notify you of any additional requirements and/or changes to upcoming deadlines.
